



# The report of utilization the European Union resources on transborder initiatives in the Euroregion Glacensis area

## THE ENTRY

The UE treats the border areas in very special way. It appreciates the fact that a mental borders which exist in consciousness of the nations could be easily conquer by the aid of the border inhabitants' initiatives, which purpose in embracing of good- neighbouring co-operation. Similar attitude to significant role, which plays border area's co-operation, border area's structure has been building by years in consciousness of political elites. One of the form of border area's structure, which after transformation period had been created in the 90', were just Euro-regions.

The Euroregions as the institutions very credible, which the members are self-government communities intended as uits or associations (in some of the Euroregions the members are also district and voivodship units), in the time of existing, were begun to be seen as institutions, which realise significant from the point of view of foreign affairs' actions, what was officially marked in appearance of representatives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. This credibility entrusted the Euroregions the implementation of national tasks in the scope of service to part of the crossborder programs.

The Polish side of the Euroregion Glacensis had an opportunity to benefit from European Union aid within the framework of the Phare Programms meanted to Middle-East Europe countries supporting, which wanted join to the European Union. That were STRUDER, RAPID and the National Phare Programms, from which were co-financed the modernisation of railway border passage Międzylesie – Lichkov on amount of 3 mln EUR. Beside the tragic circumstances of flood of the century, the main part made/had the European Union Programm ODBUDOWA. The experiences of the projects realised according to European Union procedures will bear interest in the nearest future.

In farthest consideration we will concentrate on support of the initives concerning the transborder cooperation on the Polish side of the Euroregion Glacensis.

The Glacensis Euroregion was established on 5th December 1996. the Frame Agreement about creation the Euroregion was signed in Hradec Kralove by the Association of Communities of the Kłodzko Lannd and the Regional Association for Czech-Moravian-Kłodzko Region Cross-border Co-operation. It was the first Polish-Czech Euroregion built on experiences of the first Euro-region in Middle-Eastern Europe called Nysa.

The creation of the Euroregion was facilitated thanks to working and private contacts elaborated with Czech partners. Those ctacts explained from traditional meetings of the resistance of both countries in Kłodzko border area, by the cooperation at edition the upperborder monthly „the Kłodzko Land– Od Kładského pomezí – Glatzer Bergland” since 1989 till the inauguration after a year the biggest cultural event on Polish border area “the Days of Polish-Czech Christian Culture”. The self-government units were convict for the idea of cooperation by groups mentioned above and it caused to signed the Frame Agreement about creation of the Euroregion Glacensis.

From that time important changes have reached in the Euroregion structure. Meanwhile we have opened on new members. On 26 September 2000 the District Court in Świdnica incorporated the Association of Polish Communities of the Euroregion Glacensis on the Polish side, and now there are 33 mambers from Dzierżoniów, Kłodzko, Strzelin, Wałbrzych and Ząbkowice District.

The legal subject on the Czech side is the Association of Czech-Moravian-Kłodzko Land Region – the Euroregion Glacensis, which have 85 mambers from Trutnov, Náchod, Hradec Králové, Rychnov n. Kněžnou, Ústí n. Orlici, Pardubice, Svitavy, Šumperk i Jeseník Districts.

Nowdays the Euroregion presented about 1,1 mln of inhabitants living in the area of about 5000 km.

The change of the existing formula of the associations representing the Euroregion have been follown in the moment when the European Commission entrusted to both Secretariats of the Euroregion Glacensis and accepted organisation and operation of the European Union Phare

CREDO Programm on the Polish – Czech border area. As it happened from 36 border regions participated in this Programm that we were the most active region. The Polish side of the Euroregion for 6 project realisation received total amount of 170 505,93 EUR.

That was the beginning of Euroregion adventure with Union's money. On the one hand there was ensured the financial instrument for support of transborder initiatives. On the other way the importance of keeping contacts was returned to the members, and the association by financial support.

About the important interaction of the European Union financial aid we can talk from the moment of the Phare CBC Programm accustoming. On the one hand we dealt with roads investments and protection of environment since started-up the Polish-Czech Programm and that was the lobbying role of the Euroregion.

From the beginning the implementation unit WWPWP Phare by Ministry of Internal Affairs was helping the Euroregion in this process.

The Small Projects Fund is the idea was created in Poland in the Euroregions of Polish-German borderline in mid-year ninetieth. Because of large trasborder effect of

realised projects, this Programm got the support of the European Commission. The European Commission appreciated the part of the small initiatives in the development of neighbour relations beside of problems with accounting so small amount (the value of one project is formed at the level from 1000 to 50000 EUR). That were the very original projects. The sum of organising big mass sport, recreation and cultural events was and still is supprising.

Once more the slogan "the Pole can" came true. This new sollution was implemetned in German part of the Euroregion Nysa in EU INTERREG Programm.

The JSPF Fund serves to realisation of small projects, called "soft" concerning the social sphere (eg. Cultural, sport, science iitiatives).

The financed projects:

- Support the realisation of statutory priorities of the Euroregion
- Serve as a support of integration processes of Poland and the Czech Republic with the European Union
- Base on cooperation of the foreign partners within the framework of the Programm (the more important are the partners from the Euroregion area)
- They are cofinanced by Polish and foreign partners
- They are realised in the area of the Euroregion
- They are prepared by the beneficiary to fast and effective realisation.

The projects do not include the infrastructural ventures and commerical aims. The commercial firms are not the beneficiaries of those projects.

- They inspired to organise and they support the network of local and regional entities in the fird of transborder cooperation
- They support the transborder projects realised by local and regional organizations and institutions
- They support the development of implementation and utilisation of the aid resources

The beneficiaries who have got their residence in the area of the Euroregion and who pointed the partner on the other side of the border (the partner should operate on the Euroregion area) are under the scope of activity of the JSP Fund.

The following branches of activity are the most important:

- cultural exchange
- development of local democracy
- human resources
- transborder studies and conceptions
- local democracy
- economic development and tourism.

The organisation folding the project should granted following requirements:

- to lead the local activity
- to have non-profitable character
- to fulfill public functions.

In farthest part of the publication will be presented particular editions of the Programm. The editions ZZ96 27 and 1999 – PL 99 11 were managed by the Association of Communities of Kłodzko Land. the Association of Polish Communities of the Euroregion Glacensis managed the Programm since editon 2000.

## THE PHARE CBC ZZ 96 27 PROGRAMM

The Euroregion Glacensis received the first financial resources from the Phare CBC Programm thanks to savings and unused resources in the triple Poland – Germany - the Czech Republic Programm. Decision of the Authority of Implementation the Crossborder Cooperation Programm and acceptance of the Euroregion Nysa all of the Polish – Czech Euroregions received the sum of 56 250 EUR.

The condition was immediate conducting all of the procedures or the total sum should be meant on support of

Euroregional structures. Decision of the General Meeting of the Association of Communities of the Kłodzko Land was to back prepared to realisation initiatives beside the Euroregion. Within the framework of the edition 6 projects were supported from three branches of activities – tourism, spatial planning and support of the Euroregional structures.

Three of the projects realised beside of the Euroregion concerned the conception of spatial developing of the transborder areas. The projects of the Euroregion concerned also publishings and promotion during the fair events.

Within the framework of this Programm the Publishing House "Kłodzko Land from Nowa Ruda received the amount of 50 000 EUR for monthly "the Kłodzko Land Od Kladského pomezí – Glatzer Bergland".

The beneficiaries within the framework of contracted resources – 108 278 EUR used 90 559,98 EUR which is 83,64% .

The experiences used during the realisation those projects were very helpful during the implementation the edition of Poland – the Czech Republic Programm.

## JSPF PHARE CBC POLAND- CZECH REPUBLIC 1999

Within a framework of Joint Small Project Fund Cross Border Cooperation Poland - Czech Republic in the Euroregion Glacensis there was 24 projects (of 37) supported and all of them have been realised. The total sum of these projects is 71899,46 EUR, which is 94,55% of the sum granted from the Fund - 76 000 EUR (80 000 EUR - 4 000 EUR - 5% for program's management). The total value of realised projects was 104 804,18 EUR, which shows, that medium own contribution to the realised projects was 1371,03 EUR (31,40% of the whole budget), whereas medium value of support for one project was 2995,81 EUR (which was 68,60% of the project's value).

Most projects - 8 were realised by Associations (33,33%), 6 projects were realised by Town and Community Offices (25%) and Culture and Sport Centres (25%), which was 83,33% of all of the projects.

Dominating field of the projects was cultural exchange - 14 projects (58%), residual fields were: economic development and tourism (5), support of local democracy (2), space planning and development studies (1), human resources (1) and protection of natural environment (1). Among the projects realised on the Polish part of the Euroregion Glacensis dominated events considering the tourism development and cultural exchange with special emphasis on children and youth exchange.

Among 24 projects, which had financial support from Fund

resources, more than 79% considered these two priorities including the biggest cultural event on Polish-Czech border area "the Polish - Czech Days of Christian Culture " was supported in five independent projects.

It is hard to say about significant media effect in case of the Join Small Projects Fund and all Phare CBC Program. Non - government organisations from the Euroregion Glacensis area received resources in frame of one grant comparable with all support in the PL 9911 series The Polish - Czech borderland is perceived as marginally treated with supporting sum of 5 mln EUR for the longest of Polish borderlines.

In spite of that, effects of realisation of the projects in frame of the Fund, are presented in local media especially by projects after which remain something, which are novel or try to recover something that is used to worked and was forgotten.

Among that kind of project it is worth to mentioned about three initiatives.

## PRESENTATION OF CHOSEN PROJECTS

**Title: Marking tourists attractions i the Polish part of the Euroregion Glacensis – the spatial concept and realisation**

**Beneficiary: The Association of Polish Communities of the Euroregion Glacensis**

„Marking tourists attractions by the main communication routes” is an important part of landscape of European Union countries. In Poland the discussion about legal solution has been carried on for the last 10 years. The Association of Polish Communities of the Euroregion Glacensis

sis decided to join actively works concerning acceleration the legal order for marking the tourists' attractions. The effects of realised project are the first in Poland information boards and signposts according uniform system of marking. Although on the base of the concept, about 10% of the system of boards was realised and even this small support is perceived as a big success and the effect is very important.

**Title: Agrotourist attraction- vineyard in the mountain landscape**

**Beneficiary: the Association „Zdanie” - Stara Bystrzyca**

Another novel project "Agrotourist attraction- vineyard in the mountain landscape" alludes to the history crop of grapevine in the Sudety Mountain. The Association "ZDANIE" which was a beneficiary of this project in two agriculture upper secondary schools in the Czech Republic and in Poland has created educational basis to the crop and has created common with youth the first experimental field with grapevine brought from France.

**Title: "The 1st Euroregional canoe flow - the Spring waters of the Kłodzko Land"**

**Beneficiary: Gmina Wiejska Kłodzko**

The third project, which was very conspicuous in its novel, concerned to restoration of canoe flows on the Nysa Kłodzka River and on its basins. The project of the County Municipality of Kłodzko - "The 1st Euroregional canoe flow - the Spring waters of the Kłodzko Land" was meant to create the new tourist attraction in the region. After the social and economic changes tourism and health resort be-

came a basic field of economy on Polish part of the Euroregion. The realisation of the project pointed to the need of finding the investor who would make this event not only one weekend during the year, which is full of canoes and boats on the Nysa Kłodzka River.

In the projects realised in the Euroregion Glacensis, about 4500 participants took part, about 10 000 information leaflets, maps and other publications were published, 4 workshops and 10 conferences were held, 2 concepts were created. Three of organised events had a cyclic character.

### **JSPF PHARE CBC POLAND- CZECH REPUBLIC 2000**

Within a framework of JSPF Phare CBC Poland - the Czech Republic 2000 in the Euroregion Glacensis 33 projects were planned on general sum of support 416 590,18 EUR. After the triple graduate evaluation by the Evaluation Commission, the Regional Control Committee and then by the Representative of European Commission 19 projects were supported on support sum 167 679,00 EUR and all of them were realised. Projects were realised on common sum of support 138 457,27 EUR which is 82,57% the sum granted in frame of the Fund. This sum was reduced for bank percentage- 379,28 EUR, it shows that common sum received for projects` realisation and passed to beneficiaries was 138 077,99 EUR. The total value of realised projects was 189 680,93 EUR. The own contribution of all projects was 51 223,66 EUR, the medium value of own contribution in each project was

2 695,98 EUR (27,01% of the project value), whereas medium value of the support of one project was 7287,22 EUR (which was 72,99% of the project value).

Most projects - 8, were realised by Local authorities (42%), 6 were realised by the Associations (32%), which is 74% of general amount of the projects. The residual part of beneficiaries (26%) is Culture and Sport Centres, School and other institutions.

All of the projects, which obtained the financial support from Fund resources, considered two priorities: the economy and tourist development (10) and cultural exchange (9).

### **PRESENTATION OF CHOOSEN PROJECTS**

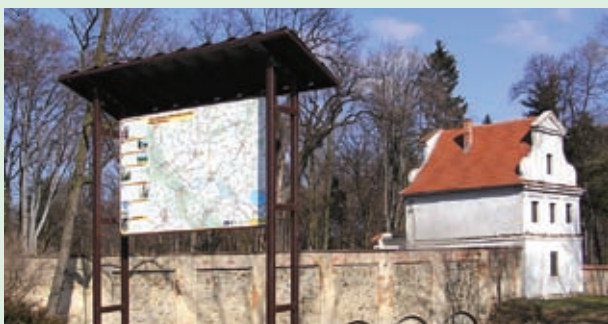
**Title: "Marking bicycle routes and tracks in Polish part of the Euroregion Glacensis"**

**Beneficiary: The Association of Communities of Kłodzko Land**

The aim of the project was economic activation of Polish part of the Euroregion Glacensis by marking about 700 km of bicycle routes and trails including information infrastructure and in this way creating new tourist product for mass receiver as well as promoting healthy and active rest and lifestyle. In the frame of the project 30 information boards with scheme of routes, 180 pieces of routes signs were made and interactive website was created. The indicator the number of marked routes was realised in 80% on the Polish side of the Euroregion. Thanks to realisation of the project the Kłodzko and Ząbkowice Land is one of three the best organised regions in Poland in field of bicycle infrastructure.

#### Title: "The Śnieżnik Cavemen Summer"

#### Beneficiary: The Community of Stronie Śląskie

The aim of the project was mutual recognition of the Polish and Czech neighbouring communities. The main event was sport and recreation happening titled "The Śnieżnik Cavemen Summer", during which different kinds of games for children and youth from Poland and the Czech Republic took place.

The main task of those games and entertainment was to create the conditions for common meetings, to make friendships and also to have a good time. In order to better integration there were dominated team competitions and the teams had mixed composition (they consisted of young people from Poland and the Czech Republic). Among played disciplines there was "the battle of fire", it is a kind of ballgame for two teams. Beside the entertainments and games for participants, many other attractions were assured for spectators- like scrambled eggs made with 1300 eggs and 10 ostrich` eggs.. The public could listen to the concerts of bands and see the performances of the theatrical groups. Beside the free of charge scrambled eggs people could taste many other traditional meals from Poland and the Czech Republic. The event "under the pretext of good enjoy" created an occasion to common recognition of border area inhabitants from Poland and the Czech Republic. Participation in the project of the foreign partner by common presentation of culture, history and also participation of inhabitants in the event contributed to common recognition. The event by its mass character and by participation of people who arrived (tourists) contributed to presentation and promotion the idea of transborder co-operation behind the Euroregion Glacensis. The advantages of the project are especially important in the context of performance of both countries in European Union structures.

#### Title: "The Sudety Mountains – Back to the Future"

#### Beneficiary: The Association "Zdanie"

The project relied on common exploration by Polish and

Czech youth the cultural and historical heritage of the Sudety Mountains. The main aim of the project was to convince the Polish and Czech youth that in the Sudety Mountains could be built common European future although the drams in the past. The participants, old inhabitants of the Sudety Mountains and representatives of German minority "autochtonia" told/related about those events, handed their experiences and memories from the past. The youth learned to see, understand and protect local relics of material culture often left by the Germans. The aims were realised by organisation of three workshops for 20 participants each and 19 Polish - Czech youth meetings with the "autochtons on the Polish and Czech side of the Sudety Mountains. The youth met also with the local culture agents, directors of museums and familiarised with the problems of 'field' relics. There were prepared two types of catalogue (in book form and as ensemble of postcards) which were distributed among the heros and participants of the project, Polish and Czech self government and culture agents. There were also prepared the multimedia presentation on CD and the exhibition of photography with the fragments of the interviews in Polish, Czech and German languages. Till this day the exhibition is to see in the European Barn of the Association "Zdanie". By the series of the testimonials, interviews and talks directed with the "autochtons" who are not numerous, about everyday life, work, God, history, neighbours, habits and tradition, young people from Czech Republic and Poland were convenient that history is never only "black and white". They will also understand that common, friendly and European future could be built not only on common heritage but as well as on dramatic events from the past. Thanks to those meetings youth understood that an important way to overcome sentiments of the past will be our common faith in unified Europe.

#### JSPF PHARE CBC POLAND- CZECH REPUBLIC 2001

Within a framework of JSPF Phare CBC Poland - the Czech Republic 2001 in the Euroregion Glacensis 51 projects were planned on general sum of support 377 540,92 EUR. After the triple graduate evaluation by the Evaluation Commission, the Regional Control Committee and then by the Representative of European Commission 19 projects were supported on support sum 126 726,00 EUR, 18 of them were contracted on the sum 123 325,00 EUR.. All of the projects were realised on common sum of support 112 131,87 EUR, which is 90,92% of the sum granted in frame of the Fund. This sum was reduced

for bank percentage- 1175,78 EUR, it shows that common sum received for projects` realisation and passed to beneficiaries was 110 956,09 EUR. The total value of realised projects was 150 131,48. EUR. The own contribution of all projects was 38 017,87 EUR., the medium value of own contribution in each project was 2 112,10 EUR (25,32% of the project value), whereas medium value of the support of one project was 6229,55 EUR, (which was 74,68% of the project value).

The biggest amount of the projects - 10 were realised by Local authorities (56%), 2 were realised by the Associations (11%), These two branches poses 67% of general amount of the projects. The residual part of beneficiaries (33%) is Culture and Sport Centres, School and other institutions.

All of the projects, which obtained the financial support from Fund resources, considered three priorities: the cultural exchange (11), the economy and tourist development (4) and concepts and development studies (3).

## PRESENTATION OF CHOSEN PROJECTS

**Title: "Dzierżonów Economic Development and Cultural Presentation 2004"**

**Beneficiary: the Town Municipality of Dzierżonów**

The main assumption of the project was starting of the economic co-operation, exchange of experiences and technique solutions among companies from both partner towns. Improvement between the two partner regions through co-operation and direct contacts of the entrepreneurs and companies from both sides of the border. The aim of the project was to revival and develop economic and rise of both regions competitive. The main event of this project were the Economic Presentations, during which took part 41 companies - and 26 from Dzierżonów District and 5 companies from the Czech Republic took part. It is quotes that 25 thousand people visited the exhibition area during the event. Cultural-sport Presentation also took place. The tennis competition for a Mayor of Dzierżonów Cup, "Bule" competition and football match took part during the sport part .

The citizens of Dzierżonów town had an opportunity to acquaint with the economic offer of the most resilient companies from partner town as well as the culture acquired possessions of this region. By establishing the possibility to take part in sport competition in different fields , the representatives of both towns could become acquainted with each other and make solid acquaintance.

The entrepreneurs from both towns established first direct

contacts which may begin with steady trade exchange. The stay of the Czech entrepreneurs and authorities allowed direct flow of conversations which resulted in the growth of mutual understanding and tolerance.

**Title: "Heritage of European Middle-age"**

**Beneficiary: the Museum of the Kłodzko Land**

The aim of the project was an enlargement of knowledge of border area inhabitants about common historic and culture roots of the both regions. Expansion of international cooperation different surroundings on cultural area, promotion of common European cultural heritage and enabling of access to a wide society to participation in it actively. In the frame of the project took place lectures for

youth, folders were printed and an exhibition considering life and activity of Arnoszt from Pardubice was organised. All activities were addressed to wide range of recipients on both sides of the border and their aim was to enrichment of knowledge about the Middle-aged cultural European heritage. The inhabitants of Pardubice and Kłodzko had an opportunity to see more than 30 original Middle-aged monuments: for the first time presented on public documents from XIV century, archaeological monuments, valuable works of art from churches, convents, museums and registries in Prague, Wrocław and Kłodzko.

The figure of Arnoszt pointed out directly on legacy of Middle-age and shown that preserved till today precious monuments represent our common European heritage. Lectures, concerts and exhibitions taking places on both sides of the border let the wide accession of society- including youth to active participation in this heritage. Contacts connected by institutions and personalities who took part in festivities bear fruit other activities- school contests for youth, exhibitions in education institutions and other activities, which will take place cyclic.

**Title: "Roots of Kłodzko County"****Beneficiary: the Culture Centre in Kłodzko**

The main aim of the project was youth integration from Polish and Czech side of the Euroregion Glacensis by artistic activities and creation of the conditions of lasting cultural co-operation in the Euroregion Glacensis. The basic activity within the framework of this project was the spectacle titled "the Battle of Troy", in which took part the Knights of the Kłodzko Count Chapter, the King's Ottokar Brotherhood, teachers from schools in Nachod, workers of the Town Museum in Kraliki and members of choirs Concerto Glacensis and from the National Music School in Kłodzko and in Bystrzyca Kłodzka, soldiers of 22<sup>nd</sup> Carpathian Brigade of Mountain Infantry in Kłodzko, pupils from schools in Kłodzko, professional actors. Czech partners joined works intensively on the project. Nachod - the partner's town of Kłodzko joined peculiarly by allowing to arrange working meetings at Townhall with instructors and experts from the King's Ottokar Knights Brotherhood. The instructors and Brotherhood knights took part in weekly workshop.

The spectacle took place at the Kłodzko market, where 6-metres high, wooden Trojan horse was placed. Near the horse there were few metres high ionic columns and the amphitheatre which was build during one evening on the scarp near the town hall. A lot of spectators came to watch the spectacle, and you could have an impress that you are in an ancient theatre. The spectacle was based on the "Odprawa posłów greckich" text by Jan Kochanowski. On the stage there were many events from philosophical disputes among the figures of the drama and moral dilemmas of the heroes to dramatic arguments and battles. The big artistic forms are an effective form of transborder co-operation because they involved participants, their families and friends in an emotional way, which contributes to significant development of personal relationships among the participants and their families on both sides of the border.

The project contributed to an increase of cultural co-operation between Polish and Czech youth from the area of Euroregion. The recipients of the spectacles, vernissages and multimedia show, by participation in the project acquainted with culture of the neighbours from Czech side of the Euroregion.

In the realised projects in the Euroregion Glacensis about 44711 participants took part, more than 12000 of publications, maps, folders, CD ROM guides, posters, leaflets were published, 111 workshops, 10 conferences, 6 youth meetings, 23 sport competitions, 2 fair events, 27 artistic events and concerts took place, 7 conceptions were created.

**JSPF PHARE CBC  
POLAND- CZECH REPUBLIC 2002**

Within a framework of JSPF Phare CBC Poland - the Czech Republic 2002 and 2003 in the Euroregion Glacensis 62 projects were planned on general sum of support 465 546,46 EUR. After the triple graduate evaluation by the Evaluation Commission, the Regional Control Committee and then by the Representative of European Commission 16 projects were supported on support sum 128 791,74 EUR and 14 were realised. Two of beneficiaries dropped the realisation of the project. Projects were realised on common sum of support 85 099,57 EUR which is 66,08% the sum granted in frame of the Fund.

This sum was reduced for bank percentage- 149,23 EUR, it shows that common sum received for projects' realisation and passed to beneficiaries was 84 950,34 EUR

The total value of realised projects was 113 470,18. EUR. The own contribution of all projects was 28 370,61 EUR, the medium value of own contribution in realised projects was 2 026,47 EUR (25% of the project value), whereas medium value of the support of one project was 6078,54 EUR (which was 75% of the project value).

The biggest amount of the projects - 10 were realised by Self-government Units (71,43%), 3 were realised by Culture and Sport Centres and the Associations realised one project.

All of the projects, which obtained the financial support from Fund resources, considered two priorities: and cultural exchange (8), the economy and tourist development (5) and protection of natural environment (1).

## PRESENTATION OF CHOSEN PROJECTS

**Title: "The Cycle of Sport Competitions for the Euro-region Glacensis Cup"**

**Beneficiary: the Association of Communities of Kłodzko Land**

The main aim of the project was promotion of transborder ski and bicycle tracks system, and also promotion of active rest in the Euroregion area.

The aim of the ski event was an activation of the Orlickie Mountains area, promotion of Polish-Czech ski tracks and to point out on activation of the Orlica transborder peak. The Euroregion Glacensis wants to restore there a view

tower, border passage on tourist track and a youth hostel in the future.

That event was an opportunity to meet friends from both sides of the border during the ski picnic. An important effect the Czech Partners participation in bicycle events was the promotion of Polish tracks system on the Czech side by providing the crossborder tourist information points with promotion materials prepared in frame of the other projects. Also by promotion the Czech Cyklobuses project, which the Poles can use them on specify border passage. In time of the meeting on shooting-gallery the representatives of self-gouvernement made acquaintance with themselves and talk about common plans considering transborder projects in the future.

**Title: "the Fairs of Polish-Czech Twin-Towns "**

**Beneficiary: the Municipality of Wałbrzych**

The aim of the project was to create the condition for developing common Polish-Czech economic undertakings and to appoint the co-operation body of business in Wałbrzych and Hradec Kralove in frame of existing businessmen organisations and supporting the direct integration between businessmen and participants of the Fair, by the personal contact and exchange of experiences.

The main motive of the project was alluding and strengthening transborder economic contacts of Polish and Czech side. Realisation of the project contributed to undertake partner's co-operation of the Communities in Wałbrzych and Hradec Kralove in new spectrum of economy co-operation.

The Czech partner joined the realisation of the Fair with big involvement. It was his task to propagate and to advertise the project among the local businessman, to find the exhibitors and to collect the applications the Czech exhibitors, to promote economic cooperation between Wałbrzych and Hradec Kralove, to prepare the promotional materials about the Czech exhibitors, including gathering materials for exhibitors' catalogue, and also logistic co-ordination while arriving the Czech exhibitors to Wałbrzych.

### JSPF PHARE CBC POLAND- CZECH REPUBLIC 2003

Within a framework of JSPF Phare CBC Poland - the Czech Republic 2002 and 2003 in the Euroregion Glacensis 62 projects were planned on general sum of support 465 546,46 EUR.

After the triple graduate evaluation by the Evaluation Commission, the Regional Control Committee and then by the Representative of European Commission 12 projects were supported on support sum 92799,17 EUR and all of them were realised. Projects were realised on common sum of support 88 726,78 EUR which is 95,61% the sum granted in frame of the Fund. In the moment of creation of the report (November 2005) only two of the projects were accounted, one of the was during accounting and rest were during realisation. Because of that i the project which were not accounted we have taken the granted sum as the utilized sum.

The total value of realised projects was 118 476,35. EUR.. The own contribution of all projects was 29749,57 EUR the medium value of own contribution in realised projects was 2479,13 EUR (25,11% of the project value), whereas medium value of the support of one project was 7393,90 EUR (which was 74,89% of the project value).

The biggest amount of the projects - 8 were realised by Local authorities (67%), 2 were realised by Non-governments Units and one by the Culture Centre and one by the Library 6 of the projects considering the "economic development and tourism", 5 projects considering the "sport and cultural exchange" and 1 project considering the "local democracy".

## **PRESENTATION OF CHOSEN PROJECTS**

**Title: “Publishing of tourist guide “Wałbrzych – Hradec Kralove” connected with promotion during the World’s Tourism Day”**

**Beneficiary: the Town Municipality in Wałbrzych**

The main aim of the project was to create conditions for tourism development in border regions by edition the Tourist Guide „Wałbrzych- Hradec Kralove” which will ensure reliable information and will be serve in education and direct integration of population from both cities and also to initiate Polish-Czech cooperation among institutions of tourist branch. The subject was to prepare and publish 3000 pieces of bilingual Tourist Guide, which will ensure to border regions’ inhabitants the access to important information about border areas. Distribution of the Guide was held by placing it in tourist branch organisations and entities, city halls of Wałbrzych and Hradec Kralove. The ceremonial promotion and presentation of the publishing took place during the Tourist Feast where participated about 800 people. During the Feast local music bands (Polish and Czech) were presented, the Guides and other tourist publishings promoting partners towns of Wałbrzych and Hradec Kralove were given out on the promotion stand. „Tourist meals” were offered to all participants of the Tourist Feast. The ending of the event was more attractive by performance of Wojtek Jarociński (the member of „Wolna Grupa Bukowina” band) and also spectacle titled „How the Liczyrzepa with Treasurer fought” of Wałbrzych` Dolls and Actor Theatre. After distribution of the Guide increased interest of the cooperation from Czech side, because representatives from Hradec Kralove city announced their participation and presentation of regional articles during the Festive Fair.

The assumption and the aim of the project was continuation of the transborder cooperation idea, its development, building the new forms of cooperation and promotion of tourists values in the region. The established aim was to support and include local accommodation links investors, local population living in border area, into activities on behalf of economic revival, promotion, tourist development by building local Polish-Czech partners connections in branch of tourism and promotion. Within the project 8 boards of municipality’s TI points, 5000 information leaflets about accommodation links and location of TI points, one available presentation of the system of tourist information on city website of Bystrzyca Kłodzka and 500 pieces of it on CD, 3 specimens by 2500 copies of promotional folders in three language versions, 2500 copies of tourist map with description in four language versions, 2500 copies of tourist informer in four

language versions were made and 10 tourist boards with region map and descriptions of tourist attractions of the region, 10 goalposts and 75 boards - direction indicators of territory were installed.

**Title: “The system of tourist information of the partner’s towns ”**

**Beneficiary: The Town Municipality in Bystrzyca Kłodzka**

The subject of the project was to organise and create an operative tourist information system by creation a network of available tourist information points in existing tourist points with involvement of tourist local investors, local population and equipped them into materials and tools necessary for giving information and also developing the network of signposts marking system within TI points, on location road of these points connected into whole system of tourist development.

6 communal TI points, 7 workshops (4 four tourist informers, 3 in the range of local initiatives development, border cooperation development were organised, multilingual data base about tourists resources, accommodation and catering objects were activated, one Polish - Czech study trip where took part 25 people and three-days Polish-Czech presentation on tourist Fairs in Poznań. The project met with big interest of Polish and Czech tourist base investors and tourists on both sides of the border. In appreciable way it facilitated an access to informations about Polish and Czech partner and brought closer to the tourists the tourist values Polish and Czech part of border area. It involved the workshops participants to further acquisition of informations and to improving experiences.

**Title: “The Fair of Regional Product – 2nd edition”**

**Beneficiary: The District Starosty in Kłodzko**

The aim of the project was to support the tourism development and to create the image of the region by promotion and creation of the regional product. The subject of the project was to present the regional product, promote the native food processing industry, handcraft and agrotourism households during the 2nd edition of the Regional Product Fair” and edition/ to present the book “the Land of Good Taste” which includes characteristic recipes for the Euroregion and presented tourist trade offers. Within the Fair the regional cuisine, nutritive articles, handcraft and products made in agrotourist households (juices, products, herbages) were submitted. The products which are made in the region, were shown during the exhibition. The project contributed to the enlargement among tourists the information about possibilities of rest in agrotourist households, regional and ecological products purchases and to development of the tourist trade in the Euroregion Glacensis area.

## BIG INFRASTRUCTURAL PROJECTS

Within the framework of the Phare CBC the support of investments from the Euroregion area concerned three Programms:

- Poland – Germany- there was cofinanced one investment project
- Triple : Poland- germany – the Cech Republic there was cofinanced one investment project
- Poland – the Czech Republic – which was started up in 1999- there were financed 3 investments projects on the Polish side and 3 projects on the Czech side- since that time it confiders “lobby” of the Euroregion Glacensis.

The effects of the program are 4 investments in ge of environment protection – sewages treatment plant in Mieroszów, Ścinawka Średnia, Międzyzlesie d Bystrzyca Kłodzka, and also 6 road investments on total sum of 15 356 934,00 EUR.

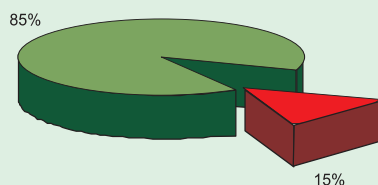

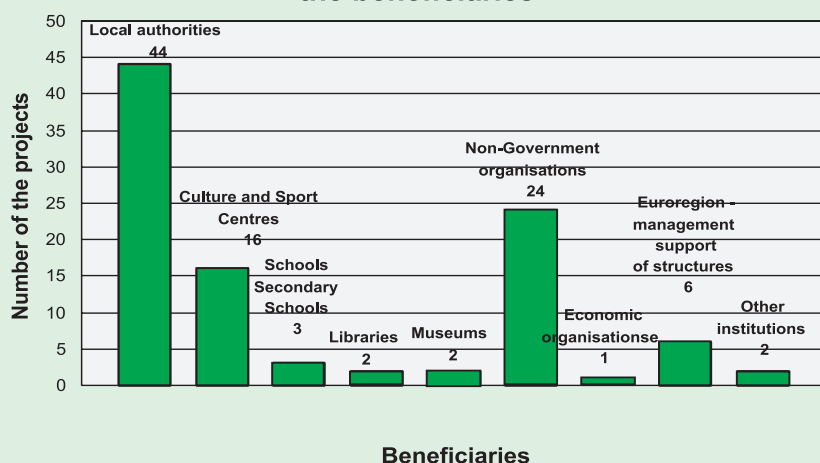
## THE SUMMARY

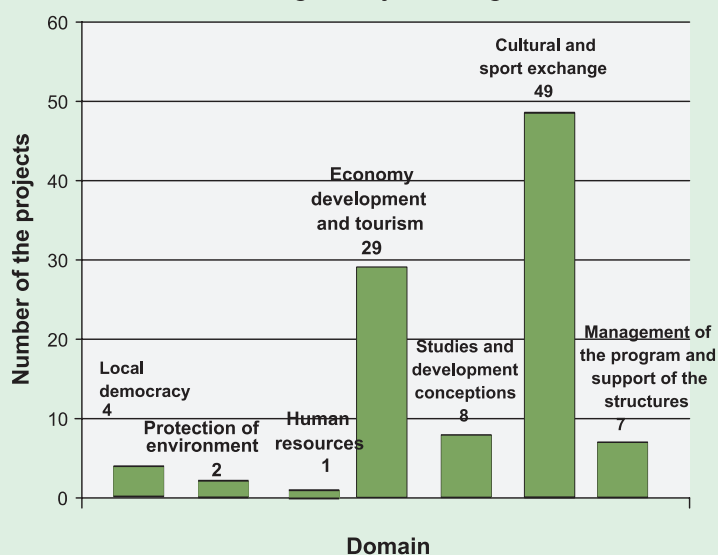
